Return to Play Procedures & Policies:

Social distancing must be maintained at all times within the facility

Entering the Facility:

- Any customers exhibiting cold or flu like symptoms (coughing, sneezing, sore throat, etc.) will not be allowed entry into the facility.
- As per SMDHU guidelines, there will be a maximum allowed capacity of 50 persons (subject to change along with guidelines).
 - A member of staff stationed at the front entrance will keep track of the number of persons within the facility at all times.
- To eliminate congestion in the lobby, the 15 minutes before your scheduled game time will be designated as IN-ONLY and customers must maintain a distance of 6 feet apart as they enter.
 - Customers will not be allowed entry prior to this period.
- Face coverings are required to enter the facility.
 - Players may remove their face covering once they are ready to take the field for warm-up and/or are situated at the players bench area.
 - All spectators must keep their face covering on for the duration of their stay.
 - The following individuals are not required to wear a face covering:
 - Children under two years of age, or children under the age of five years either chronologically or developmentally who refuse to wear a mask and cannot be persuaded to do so by their caregiver.
 - Individuals with medical conditions rendering them unable to safely wear a mask, including those with breathing difficulties or cognitive difficulties or difficulties in hearing or processing information.
 - Anyone who is unable to remove the mask without help.
 - Individuals who cannot wear face coverings for any religious reasons.
- All customers will be greeted by team member that will ask them the follow the questions:
 - *Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs?*
 - *New or worsening cough* Yes No

- *Shortness of breath* Yes No
- *Sore throat* Yes No
- *Runny nose, sneezing or nasal congestion (in absence of underlying reasons for symptoms such as seasonal allergies and post nasal drip)* Yes No
- *Hoarse voice* Yes No
- *Difficulty swallowing* Yes No
- *New smell or taste disorder(s)* Yes No
- *Nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain* Yes No
- *Unexplained fatigue/malaise* Yes No

- *Have you travelled outside of Canada or had close contact with anyone that has travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?* Yes No
- *Do you have a fever?* Yes No
- *Have you had close contact with anyone with respiratory illness or a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?* Yes – No
- Those who answer **YES** to any question or refuse to answer, will be denied access to the building.
- All customers will be required to sign in to assist with contact tracing.
 - When signing in, you are also acknowledging that insurance does not cover illness due to Covid-19.
- Please make any food & beverage purchases at the lobby counter upon entry when possible.
- All persons will be directed to a designated area within the Dome depending on whether you are a player or spectator and which field you will be playing/warming-up on.
 - A staff member will be able to assist you where to go.
 - Clear signage will also help direct you to the correct area.
- No spectators allowed for adult games.
- Spectators for youth games (under 18) will be limited to 1 parent.
 - Please refrain from bringing siblings unless absolutely necessary. Any siblings who must attend a game are required to stay with the parent at all times.
- Changerooms will be closed.
 - Please change prior to entering the facility.

Preparing for the Match:

- Players will only enter the field through the designated entry point once players from the previous match have cleared.
- Spectators will proceed to the designated viewing area once spectators from the previous match have cleared.
- All seating will be marked to allow for social distancing.
 - Players benches will be replaced with chairs 6 feet apart.

- We recommend players disinfect chairs with the provided sanitizing materials before use.

Exiting the Facility:

- Upon completion of your match, there will be no handshakes.
- Immediately put face covering back on to exit the facility.
- Head directly to the revolving door to exit while maintaining social distancing measures.
- To avoid lobby congestion, the 15 minutes following the completion of your match will be designated as an EXIT-ONLY period.

Using the Washrooms and/or Lounge:

- Maintain social distancing at all times when utilizing these areas of the facility.
- Lounge: Maximum 10 people at one time.
- Washrooms: 1 person at a time.
 - Wait in the lobby or the men's changeroom alcove for previous user to clear.

On Field Rules (In addition to regular indoor soccer rules):

- Face to face verbal confrontations will be strictly prohibited.
 - The instigating player will receive an **automatic red card** for any such activity.
- Spitting on the field is strictly prohibited.
 - First infraction will be a yellow card; second infraction will be a red card.
- Games can be played with as few as 5 players on the field (including a keeper).
 - Teams are asked to match the opposing team's number of players on the field.
 - Co-Ed teams will only require 1 female on the field at a time for the Return to Play schedule.

Facility Cleaning & Sanitizing Protocols:

- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided in strategic locations throughout the facility including by the players bench area. All persons are encouraged to utilize these stations, especially upon entry and exit.
- All common touch points will be sanitized every 2 hours when facility is in use.
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- At the end of each day, staff will complete an extensive sanitizing list of the whole facility.

- Staff will all be trained and/or re-trained on cleaning & sanitizing protocols to ensure effective techniques and instructions are being followed.
 - Training and completion of sanitizing protocols will be documented.
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Staff Protocols:

- Staff will be asked to wear face coverings while in the facility.
 - Protective barriers will be installed at the lounge counter for customer services including food/drink service.
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In Case of a Positive Test:

- Upon confirmation of a positive test by a member of staff, all other members of staff will be required to get tested and return a negative result before returning to work.
 - Any member of staff who tests positive will be required to follow SMDHU guidelines for quarantine and must return 2 consecutive negative test results to be able to return to work.
 - Upon confirmation of a positive test by a customer or member of staff, all persons who were in the facility at the same time or on the same day following the customers visit or member of staff's shift, will be notified.
 - SMDHU guidelines will determine next steps of action.
